


Advent Truth Newsletter May 2015


The two prophecies of Daniel 2 and 7 parallel each other, covering the kingdom of Babylon, Medo-Persia, Greece, Rome, Europe and finally God's Kingdom. Please see the diagram below.

The terrible beast represents Rome and the 10 horns symbolise the divided nations of Europe under Papal Rome which followed the collapse of Pagan Rome. Then follows a heavenly judgement, the saints will receive the Kingdom and all earthly empires will come to an end.







